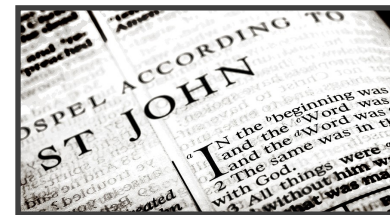

Pastor Greg's new Bible study on the Gospel of John began today. This study will be held every Sunday before the service at 8:45am. Hope you can join us!

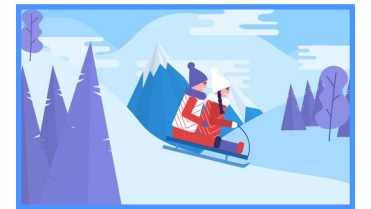
### Coffee Service is Back!

Youth please meet up-stairs in



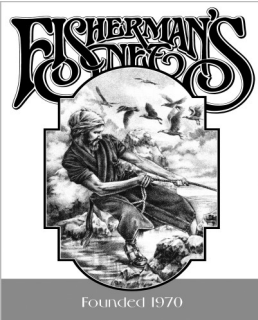
the youth group room after today's service for a pizza lunch before we go sledding and afterwards we'll come back for hot chocolate and snacks. Families of the youth are welcome to join us.
